THE LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLES

Tonight we relight the four Advent candles. Once again, let us recall the purpose of the four candles. The first candle reminds us of the marvelous HOPE revealed through the Savior's birth. In a time of despair, God shattered the darkness with the HOPE of a new future. The second candle helps us remember that God's perfect LOVE made flesh can fill our hearts, ignite our souls, and change our lives. The third candle reminds us that our JOY abides in God who gently whispers to each human heart, "Come follow me, for I have come that you might have life and have it to the fullest measure." The fourth candle represents the gift of PEACE. This candle symbolized God's perfect PEACE in an imperfect world that is filled with discord.
